St James and St John School in Akeley, near Buckingham, invited Dr Harin Sellahewa and Dr Tuan Nguyen to deliver an interactive Computing session with 22 of their Year 6 pupils on 20 June 2018.

Pupils were shown how to write and decipher programming code, and given the opportunity to experience augmented reality using HoloLens headsets.

Nick Davidson, Year 6 teacher at the school, said "The sessions were excellently resourced and delivered. The coding/cipher activity was perfect for a Year 6 group as it linked into lots of Maths, especially the algebra we start to study in Year 6. It was great to see algebra (which often seems abstract) used to explain how the code can be broken."

One of the students was particularly inspired by this part of
